Penalty Structure

Football Ontario has established a penalty structure to enforce in accordance with their By-laws, Policies, and Procedures that all members, registered participants and any other individual participating within a Football Ontario Sanctioned event must adhere to. Failure to comply with any Football Ontario policy and regulation will result in a monetary fine for said infraction. Penalties can be imposed on Member Associations and Leagues.

Members must pay fine fees in order to remain a member in good standing with Football Ontario. Membership Renewal for the proceeding year may be denied if payment of fees is outstanding. Infractions will be defined as outlined in Football Ontario's Member Conduct as minor or major infractions.

Implementation of Penalties:

1. Minor infractions will be imposed a fine of \$250.
2. Major infractions will be imposed a fine of \$500.

Repeated infractions will result in additional penalties that will be doubled of the original penalty.

A league that has member associations with unpaid penalties are subject to a \$250 penalty.

All penalties may be appealed in accordance with Football Ontario's Appeal Policy.
