- Member of Football Canada and their Provincial Sport Organization
- Fully Certified NCCP Level III or in-training in the NCCP Competition-Development Context (Completion of Safe Contact, Making Headway in Football, Competition Development (MED) Making Ethical Decisions and 1 of the 6 multisport modules)
- Coached at an elite level (i.e. CFL, CIS, CJFL, CEGEP, Senior Women's Leagues, World Championships, National Championships, or Provincial Championships)
- Coach for at least a three-year period
- Proven record of experience in coaching events involving American football rules (i.e. exhibition games, exchanges, summer camps) considered an asset
- Experience coaching women will be considered an asset
