# Logistics

## Coach and Executive Team Information

1. If any roster updates are needed to be made, please inform our events intern of any updates. If no roster updates are needed, we will move forward with the rosters that were shared with us.
2. All players and coaches must sign in with Football Ontario staff prior to their game. Teams will be assigned a sign-in time.
3. Please review the [5-a-side Rulebook](#) before the competition

## Preparation

1. Athletes must come with cleats, a mouthguard, and appropriate clothing for the Tournament - No pants or shorts with pockets.
2. **Flags** will be available for use during the tournament provided by Football Ontario.
3. Athletes' names must be on the roster sheet submitted to Tyler or Aaron to be permitted on the field.
4. **Footballs** will need to be provided by the team
5. All players and coaches must sign in with Football Ontario staff prior to their game. Teams will be assigned a sign-in time.

## Day of Tournament

1. Register and sign your team in with Football Ontario staff at least **30 minutes** prior to your first game (teams will be told what time to arrive and sign in by).
2. **Spectators are welcome at this event**
3. Parking will be available at the field.
4. Teams must be on the field **ON TIME**. Teams must have a minimum of seven players to be able to play a game.
5. A **medical tent** will be set up by both fields – we will have staff on hand to deal with emergency response and injury (including taping for injuries and stability)

**PLEASE NOTE MEDICAL TAPE WILL NOT BE GIVEN OUT TO TAPE POCKETS OR SPAT CLEATS**


## Game Play & Schedule

All games including semis, and finals will have 2 officials. All officials are certified with the Southern Ontario Touch Football Officials Association.

Teams will be guaranteed a total of 4 games to play. The schedule for the tournament is presented below.

Flags will be provided for the games. Teams are responsible for bringing their own footballs and jerseys for their players. Athletes must wear proper attire (Cleats, mouthguard, proper clothes) to be able to participate in the tournament.

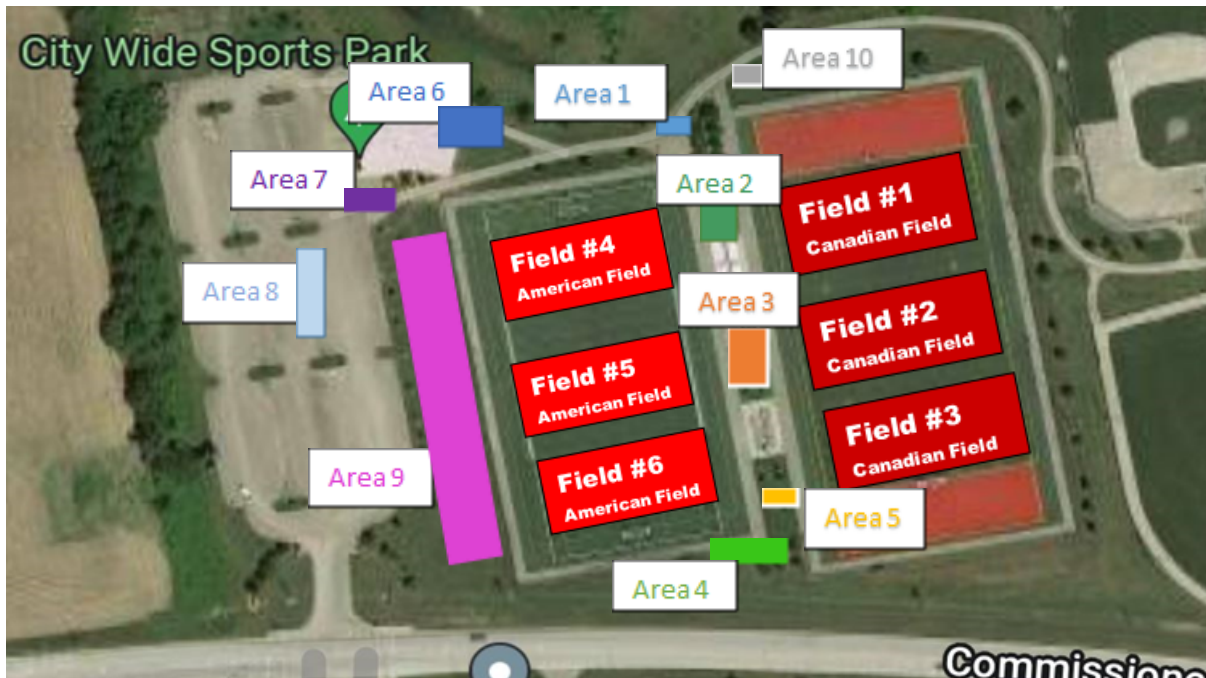
**Prizes:** Tournament winners (first place team) will receive gold medals. The runner-up (second-place team) will receive silver medals. The third-place team will receive bronze medals.

## Emergency Action Plan

**Event:** Football Ontario Flag Tournament

**Venue:** Citywide Sports Park

**Address:** 1510 Commissioners Road East, London, ON, N6M 1E8

**AED:** The AED is located inside the facilities building, on the right wall

### EMS ACCESS:



### Procedure:

1. First response to injuries on-field will be the sideline trainer - **CHARGE PERSON**
2. A SIGNAL OF A RAISED ARM WITH A CLOSED FIST will be used to summon the second trainer on-field to aid in the situation who will be the **CONTROL PERSON**
  - a. NOTE: in the event of a c-spine injury with the Charge Person unable to raise their arms, they will inform the coach to signal the Control Person
3. If EMS is needed, the **CONTROL** person will notify **CALL PERSON** either directly or by CROSSING ARMS OVERHEAD IN AN X and give details on the EMS call priority.

**CHARGE:** \_\_\_\_\_ (**Trainer**) Take charge & focus on medical care of the injured athlete

**CONTROL:** \_\_\_\_\_ (**Second Trainer**) Activate EMS (Signal/Call) when directed to do so, provide support to Charge person, get equipment/supplies, control bystanders. If second trainer is not available, then assistant coach will become control person

**CALL PERSON:** \_\_\_\_\_ (**Team Manager**) Activate EMS by calling from cell phone.

**Sideline Control:**

1. As soon as the **CALL PERSON** is signaled, the **Head Coach** and **Team Captain** are responsible for getting players off of the field and keeping them calm
2. The **Game Day Coordinator** must contact Citywide employees to open the emergency access gate and will meet the EMS, then direct them to the **CONTROL PERSON**
3. The Game Day Coordinator will signal a **volunteer** to wait for EMS at the TD main entrance and direct them to the emergency access gate

**AED Procedure:**

1. **CHARGE PERSON** will **SIGNAL** to the **CONTROL PERSON**.
2. **CALL PERSON** will activate EMS by calling from cell phone.
3. **CONTROL PERSON** will retrieve AED and assist **CHARGE PERSON** with CPR.
4. **CHARGE PERSON** applies **AED** apparatus, **CONTROL PERSON** continues CPR until AED is activated.

**Nearest Hospital:**

For urgent injuries that require medical attention but do NOT require an ambulance, the nearest hospital is Children's Hospital (approximately 7 minutes driving) located at:

**Directions:**

- Turn right onto Commissioners Road East
- Turn right onto Western Counties Road. You will see the sign for Victoria Hospital Commissioners Entrance
- Turn left at the stop sign
- Continue straight. The emergency entrance will be on the right
